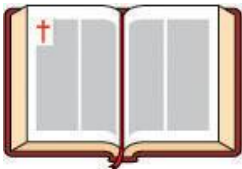
Welcome Home!

It is a failure to respect God in the use of our lips

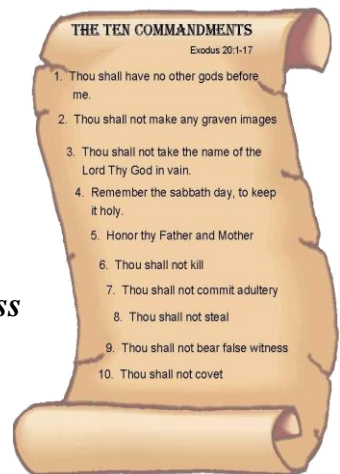
Words are life-giving
