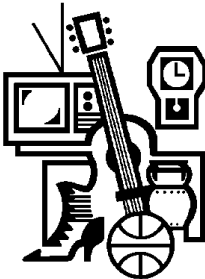
Yard Sale! Books! Hot Dogs & Bake Sale
